4. Be able to represent the Treasure Valley Dairy Industry in a positive manner including public appearances, and educational programs.
5. Must NOT be a graduating senior.

- The deadline to turn in applications is April 29th.
- If more than 12 applications are received, we reserve the right to possibly have an essay run-off contest.
